



Week 1: Teach Roles & Action Pattern





Roles

Action

Domino Discover



Students' Role

☐ Reporters: Take turns reporting out one at a time from each group, like Dominos falling one after another without any interruptions.

Teacher and Students' Role

☐ Listeners: Listen for the goal assigned by the teacher



Set a Goal for Listeners




Gather student responses to:

- discover *patterns* and *surprises* in thinking
- ☐ test ability to justify an idea with evidence
- ☐ use a vocabulary word properly in a meaningful context
- ☐ gather questions
- ☐ build on to the responses of other students

Teacher: Ask a question





Allow students to think and discuss answers




















Ask all students to listen for something specific (goal)




Make sure every table has a response and two back-up ideas before starting the domino




Direct reporters to share the answer or




Contribute a back-up discussed at their table




Call on one person to be the reporter




Call on any student, so all must be prepared




Encourage reporters to ask tablemates for help




Allow students to "huddle" to prepare the reporter




Gather one response from each table



Continue until each table has been heard

Now, call on hands for additional responses






Teaching Tip 2: Small Group Variation




Each student answers the question in their small group




The first domino is around each table in the room




Be sure to assign who will speak first




and the direction of the domino




Then complete a class Domino to hear from each group




Be sure to remind students of why







Create rules for the process to ensure engagement for everyone




Say "confirm" if you are repeating another groups' response
